Curbside recycling and yard waste services are provided year round, on an alternating, every other week basis.

Here are some basic guidelines for sorting and preparing your recyclables.

Gray Bin

Acceptable: Aluminum cans, rinsed tin cans, #1 PETE plastic bottles (transparent, any color), #2 Plastics With the exception of the following:

NOT acceptable: NO Motor oil or other hazardous material jugs, No yogurt or other food containers, NO other plastics. NO food contaminated or other contaminated materials.

Blue Bin

Acceptable: Rinsed clear, brown and green glass bottles and jars

NOT acceptable: NO light bulbs, broken glass, ceramics, window or Pyrex glass. NO food contaminated bottles or jars or other contaminated materials.

Acceptable: Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, mail, phone books.
Please put mail in separate bag inside bin.

Beige Bin

Corrugated cardboard boxes should be flattened and tied in bundles set next to bins.

NOT acceptable: TetraPak (milk cartons), waxed cardboard or paper, wrapping paper, black carbon paper. NO food contaminated boxes or other contaminated materials.

YARD WASTE PREPARATION: Includes grass clippings, leaves, plant and tree prunings.

Maximum of 3 units per pickup, put out in any combination of the following:

1. A biodegradable paper bag designed for yard waste. This bag is composted with your yard waste.
2. A 32 gallon or less garbage can, clearly labeled "Yard Waste" on two sides.
3. Tied bundle of limbs or branches no longer than 4 ft. and 2 ft. in diameter; limit 40 lb. each.
4. A three (3) mil plastic bag. **This is the least desirable option, because the bags cannot be recycled.**
5. We also accept bare Christmas trees for recycling, cut in half. Trees with flocking or tinsel can be taken as garbage and you will be charged extra accordingly.

Hints from Your Hauler:

The following hints can help us better serve you and help you control your costs:

- Take advantage of both the recycling and yard waste collections. The cost is already included in your bill, so the more you recycle, the less garbage you will have to pay for. If you need recycling bins, please call 385-6612.
- Keep the can size to 32 gallons or less. This will avoid oversized can charges.
- Keep the can weight below 50 pounds each, again to avoid oversized charges.
- If you are going away for more than a month, call us before you leave and we will put your account on a temporary stop, and reduce your cost accordingly.
- **If you are an every other week customer, put your garbage can out on the same week as yard waste. This will avoid your being charged for an extra pickup on the wrong week.**
- **Make sure your cans have tight fitting lids to keep out animals and keep our city free of litter.**
- Have your garbage, recycling, or yard waste out by 7:30 AM.
