Description of Proposal: The City of Port Townsend proposes to update its Parks, Recreation and Open Space Functional (herein after “Parks Functional Plan”). The Parks Functional Plan was first adopted in 1999 and has not been amended, updated or modified since. The purpose of this update is to:

- Provide a current inventory of existing parks & recreation facilities and programs;
- Set forth key issues and recommendations for all facets of parks & recreation service delivery; and,
- Ensure the City is in compliance with State grant funding programs

The planning area for the Parks Functional Plan contains the entire City.

Location: If adopted, the proposed Plan will apply City-wide.

Public Hearing. On **Thursday, July 14, 2011**, at or about **6:30 p.m.**, the Planning Commission will be conducting an open-record hearing on the above-referenced application. The public hearing will take place in the Council Chambers, City of Port Townsend City Hall, 540 Water Street, Port Townsend. The Draft Parks Functional Plan to be considered by the Planning Commission is available for public review at the Development Services Department on the third floor of City Hall. The Draft Parks Functional Plan is also available online at the City’s website: www.cityofpt.us.

All interested parties may appear at the July 14 hearing and provide oral or written testimony. Oral testimony may be limited to 3 to 5 minutes per person. The purpose of the public hearing is to review the Draft Parks Functional Plan for consistency with the current Comprehensive Plan, and testimony should be limited to that review. Testimony on other issues, such as future uses at Kah Tai Lagoon, should be reserved and take place when those issues are dealt with in separate processes, including proposed amendments to the Comprehensive Plan), that will occur at a later date.
