Thank you for your letter dated September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2011 recommending a ~78.5 acre 6(f) boundary for Kah Tai Park in Port Townsend. It's evident you and your staff have carefully reviewed the materials at hand. The National Park Service concurs with your boundary determination with one small exception. NPS recommends the boundary not cross north of the southern edge of 19<sup>th</sup> Street/Blaine Street.

Please submit an official, signed 6(f) map along with three original amendments, a Description and Notification Form (DNF) and a 424 in order to finalize this boundary determination.
