

Mountain View Pool Private Lessons

As a community pool, it is our goal to be accessible for everyone. Your enjoyment of the pool and all it has to offer is our priority, and we believe that aquatic education will enrich people for a lifetime. We strive to teach our community the safety and skills required to achieve wellbeing in the water.

Mountain View Pool facilitates this through group and private swimming lessons, as well as renting our facility to private organizations such as Port Townsend Swim Team, Olympic Peninsula Aquatics (also known as Tsunami Synchronized Swimming), and the Master's swim program. We encourage everyone to use all available resources to enhance their swimming repertoire.

In order to improve community service and outreach, we have provided a code of conduct for our private lessons. Listed below, you will find the guidelines the pool uses in scheduling private lessons. These rules are set by the pool staff and cannot be altered or changed. Thank you so much for your continued support in our aquatics community.

- Private lessons will be offered by City of Port Townsend employees at the Mountain View Pool
- Lifeguards and Group Lessons are priority and staffed first to most effectively use our budget. Private lessons will be staffed with remaining available hours. It is our goal to reach the maximum amount of members in our community and their aquatic needs.
- We understand that private lessons are important you; and they are in high demand. Unfortunately, we have limited spaces available per-month, therefore, registration opens Monday at 5:30 am two (2) weeks before class begins. They will be scheduled first come, first serve basis.
- Mountain View Pool will staff our private lessons according to staffing availability. You may request an instructor, but you may not get the instructor that you have requested. This is non-negotiable.
- Class length will run from 3 to 4 weeks depending on the month. The class cost will change to reflect hours of the class. (i.e. four half-hour lessons will be less expensive than four one-hour classes)
- We do not offer make-up lessons for private lessons.
- Our goal is to have the same staff work with the swimmer for the whole session. But emergencies and illness happen, if for some reason, the instructor is unable to teach a lesson, we will have another instructor teach in their place.
- The City of Port Townsend does not offer semi-private lessons; however we are able to split Saturday hour long lessons into two thirty minute sessions for two participants.
